Our road safety campaign started this week and, as you may have seen, we have had great success in significantly reducing the danger to our children from congestion on the roads in and around school.

From monitoring the area, we have identified several factors that greatly contribute to the danger in the area which together cause serious congestion which leads to POOR VISION and BLOCKS ACCESS for our children and families to cross the road safely:

- Parking in red hot spot areas, especially on bends (PLEASE SEE ATTACHED MAP)
- Speed of cars entering Faulkner way
- Vehicles mounting and driving along the pavement
- Volume of traffic entering Faulkner Way

So please help to continue to make this safer by:

- *** NOT ENTERING FAULKNER WAY** if possible*
- * NOT DRIVING OR PARKING IN OR AROUND SCHOOL

We also presented to the Parish Council on Wednesday who are fully behind this campaign and we will continue working with them, along with our authorities, on ideas for improvements that can be made.

The Parish Council have also further supported us by installing a CCTV camera on Faulkner Way, outside of the school so that they can continue to monitor the situation.

We are very grateful to everybody involved in making this a success, with a special thank you to the local PCsO's and PCs who came to support us this week.
