



## How to Make Ice Paint

### Materials

Washable paint  
An ice-cube tray  
Water

### Method

Begin by filling an ice cube tray roughly 1/3 of the way with paint, rotating colours as desired.

Fill the ice slots the rest of the way with warm water and carefully stir until combined.

Pop the ice tray(s) in the freezer for 4-6 hours.

Then, play can begin!

### Ice Paint Play

Once the paint cubes are frozen they will easily pop out of the ice trays.

Give kids paper, and they will have a blast creating beautiful, icy works of art.
