

Key Vocabulary	
Duration	The musical name for how long a sound or note is (short or long)
Pattern	An arrangement of ideas that are repeated
Notation	Symbols and pictures to match our music, we are using notation. It can be in simple form or as musical notes
Timbre	The different sounds made by different voices or instruments. Voice – whisper, hum, sing or talk.
Pulse	The steady beat
Rhythm	Follows the pattern of words, it is often different to the pulse
Compose	To create a piece of music
Solo	To sing or play on your own
Unison	To sing or play the same part altogether

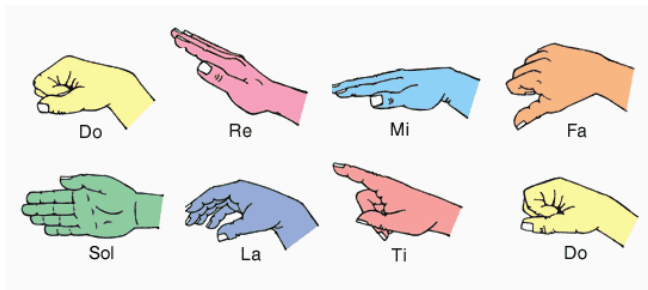
