

Key Vocabulary

Round	A type of cannon, in which the same song is sang in groups starting at different times
Interval	The difference/ relationship between two notes
Ostinato	A repeating rhythm pattern
Pentatonic	A scale of 5 notes over an octave
Texture	Layers of sound in a piece of music
Drone	Where a note or chord is continuously sounded
Pitch	How high or low a note is
Rhythm	Follows the pattern of words. It is often different to the pulse
