So far we have been working with the children, parents, staff, governors, neighbours, PCSOs, and the Parish Council

Starting on 1st Oct 15:

- new banners and signs and CCTV will be positioned at the school entrances
- PCSOs will be present at drop off and pick up times to advise drivers of potentially dangerous situations
- ☆ JRSOs, parent helpers, school staff and PCSOs will assist in advising drivers of alternatives to driving and parking in the area around school

In the future we hope to work with the Parish Council and Local Authorities on bigger projects such as:

- Can any improvements be made to the road markings and signage?
- Can any improvements be made to the road layout?
